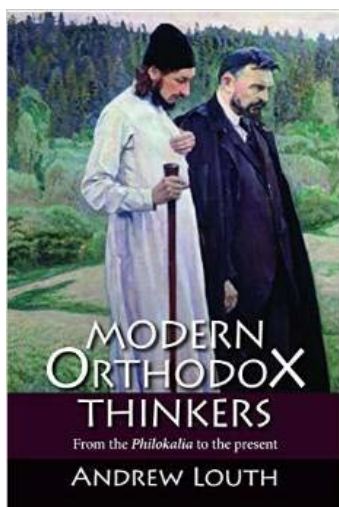


Modern Orthodox Thinkers: From the Philokalia to the present

The presentation of the book *Modern Orthodox Thinkers* by Very Revd. Prof. Andrew Louth will be the occasion for a small colloquy on 4 September 2015. Fr. Andrew, who taught patristics in Oxford and Durham, was for four years Guest Professor of VU University Amsterdam. The book contains the lectures Fr. Andrew gave each month during a course spanning two years. The result is a unique overview of the richness and variety of Orthodox thinking since the publication in 1782 of the anthology of writings called the *Philokalia*.

Transport and parking

From the railway and metro station Amsterdam WTC Zuid to the Medical Faculty is a 10 minutes walk.
